This book tells the story of an encounter between a science journalist – Hélène – and a famous physicist – Edgard – who suggests that she write a book about the popularisation of science. Very soon, the original project opens up new perspectives and Hélène learns of her collaborator's incredible story: a child in hiding during the war, his father disappears, taken to the camps. He finds himself with a mother who is a fervent communist on the other side of the 'Iron Curtain'; more precisely, in Poland. This book is a wonderful illustration of how the little and the big stories of our world become intertwined somewhere between theories of the universe and personal journeys.
