


## Jacques Neirynck

Belgian by birth, French by marriage and naturalised Swiss, Jacques Neirynck was born in Brussels on 17 august 1931. A recognised scientist, elected politician in Switzerland, popularizer and teacher, he is also a successful novelist.

Jacques Neirynck's trilogy, *Un pape suisse*, sees the completion of a fascinating project that belongs somewhere between science, history and police conspiracy. Well before the *Da Vinci Code*'s international success, he had begun work, with the dating of the famous Turin shroud as his starting point, on a fresco that would take us back to the origins of Christianity. In a lively and erudite and yet never abstruse style, Jacques Neyrinck undertakes a totally new rapprochement of science and faith with the help of two brothers: Theo, a utopian physicist and Emmanuel who will become, under the name of John XXIV, the first Swiss pope in history.
